



# Net Zero Commitment



Turnbull is committed to raising awareness of and helping our stakeholders understand the global climate emergency. Global Net Zero emissions are achieved when the emissions of greenhouse gases produced by human activities balance the removal of these gases from the atmosphere over a given period. These emissions are commonly expressed as carbon dioxide equivalent (CO<sub>2</sub>e) or referred to as carbon emissions.

## Net Zero Targets

We are committed to playing our part in helping to contribute towards the Global, National and Local Net Zero targets:

- Build knowledge and capacity to meet climate change.
- Strengthen resilience and adaptive capacity to climate related disasters.

## Our Action

At Turnbull, we are focusing our efforts on creating our carbon footprint to identify our baseline carbon emissions. This will determine what actions and changes to our business activities we will need to implement to achieve Net Zero. Whilst we continue to understand and examine our carbon emissions, we have set commitments to act upon which will help us to actively reduce our operational carbon emissions. Examples of our commitments include:

- reducing the number of diesel generators used in our operations;
- working with our PPE supplier to create a circular solution for our workwear;
- re-using materials, improving resource efficiency and explore cleaner energy solutions;
- using sustainable transport options for business travel.
